- 2. Academic excellence** — *A grade transcript for all 4 years is required.*
- 3. Extra curricular activity** — *List all work and volunteer history, involvement in school programs and any awards received.*
- 4. Essay (personal statement)**
- 5. Interview** — *Will be scheduled with all finalists.*

*If a sibling has already received The Trashmasters Scholarship,  
a younger sibling will not be considered.*

**This fully completed application plus the requested documents are required to be considered for a Trashmasters scholarship.**
